

## ALDRIDGE CRICKET CENTRE BRIGHTON ALDRIDGE COMMUNITY ACADEMY

The Aldridge Foundation was launched in 2006 to support social change and community regeneration. In partnership with the Brighton Aldridge Community Academy, the Portslade



Aldridge Community Academy and Sussex Cricket, the Aldridge Cricket Academy provides coaching programmes for male and female cricketers, as well as providing students with a broad and thriving academic programme.

Situated within the Brighton Aldridge Community Academy campus the new building provides three lanes of cricket nets with full run ups, a gym, physiotherapy/medical room and a cricket pavilion which incorporates changing facilities for two teams and officials, a social area and ancillary accommodation, all in line with ECB guidelines for best practice.



Of steel frame construction the brickwork and cladding complement the existing larger Academy buildings. External works, which were carried out by the in-house Groundworks and Civil Engineering Department, include an entrance ramp, car parking and adjusting ground contours.
