THE ANGMERING SCHOOL ANGMERING WEST SUSSEX

The Angmering School provides education for pupils aged 11-18. Due to a local shortage of secondary school places, the school has been enlarged to 9 forms of entry.

The new accommodation, carried out in five phases, comprises a three storey 25 classroom teaching block for science, art and maths; a small extension to the existing changing block to



provide two additional changing rooms; an infill extension between the performing arts department and the dining hall to provide a dance studio/stage and the demolition of two modular buildings. Internal re-modelling included new pupil WCs, conversion of two art rooms and alteration and refurbishment of five existing laboratories.

The main building has SFS/facing brick external walls, metal stud partitions, steel frame, metal deck roof with single ply membrane covering, precast upper floors and staircases, beam and block ground floor, aluminium windows and curtain walling. Extensive temporary propping was required for the new opening formed in the dining hall external wall of approximately 11m x 6m high.

Groundworks and civil engineering, which were carried out by the company's in-house department included foundations, drainage/SUDS drainage, roads and landscaping. The site compound fill was recovered and transported to another Sunninghill project site for reuse.

A close working relationship with the school was maintained throughout to ensure safety and welfare of pupils, staff and visitors, and to limit any possible disruption to the day to day running of the school.
