PATCHAM HIGH SCHOOL PATCHAM BRIGHTON

The school has over 1000 pupils aged between 11 and 16 and is situated in the heart of Patcham. The project, which will increase dining and examination facilities comprised the construction of a new hall, built into a space between three existing buildings.



The project commenced on this restricted site with the RC ground bearing slab and the construction of a structural steel frame with an aluminium standing seam roof covering on metal profiled decking. The building façade is finished in insulated Rockpanel cladding.

Works included breaking through to an existing corridor and the formation of a new stage opening into the new hall which now allows dual aspect use of the stage by means of sliding folding partitions. This work was carefully coordinated with the school and much was carried out during half term and Easter holidays to limit any disruption to the school's day to day activities.

Groundworks and civil engineering which were carried out by the Company's in-house department included the formation of a temporary access road which has since been retained.
